Association of Seventh-day Adventist Historians (ASDAH) and Adventism in China (AIC) <u>www.adventisminchina.org</u> are sponsoring a conference on *Reflection on Adventism in China and Asia* at **Hong Kong Adventist College** (HKAC), October 30 – 31, 2014. You are cordially invited to submit papers for presentation at the conference.

2014 marks 112 years of Adventism in China and East Asia, since Jacob & Emma Anderson, and Ida Thompson arrived in Hong Kong on February 2, 1902 as missionaries of the SDA Church. However, gospel ground works were laid unofficially by Abram La Rue for 14 years since 1888. This conference provides a unique opportunity for reflection on the history and impacts of Adventism in East Asia.

- Christian concepts in ancient China
- Adventist believers in China today
- Impact of Adventism in East Asia
